Literacy (L)

We will write birthday cards / invitations for our new friends we have made.

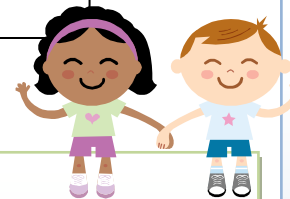
Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)
