Where possible, English lessons are linked to our topics. We also incorporate SPAG into our lessons, where appropriate.


Children will be expected to continue to use their cursive handwriting in all their work to increase fluency and control.

#### **Homework**

We are continuing to use a range of homework activities this term, you will need to choose at least 3 of these and continue with weekly spelling, reading and times table practice (3s, 4s, 8s).

Spellings will be sent out weekly (5 common exception words, 5 taught spelling rule) These will be sent out on Friday and tested the following Friday

#### **Intervention**
