Once children are able to read fluently, and with expression, we would encourage you to hold discussions around their comprehension of the texts (we will provide a bank of ideas to support this). If your child is reluctant to read, they could listen to audio books. We want them to foster a love of books, so please don't underestimate the value of reading to your child. We are all very grateful for your support.

Added Extras:

We will encourage your child to complete as many of the activities from the menu as they like at home, but NO LESS than 3 over the half term, This can be recorded (if appropriate) in our homework books. We will ask for homework books in during the last week of each half term in order for us to share and celebrate this learning.

<p>Your reading challenge is to read some articles. You can find these in newspapers and in magazines. Why don't you cut some out and put them in your homework book to show what you have found.</p> 	<p>Research what conditions plants need to live. We have learnt a little about this in class already but can you find out more? Is it the same for each plant? Do some plants prefer hot or cold climates? Do all plants need the sun to help them grow?</p> 	<p>Design your own species of plant. Consider why you make the choices you do. For example your plant may have a strong stem so it can grow to 4.m tall as it is a favourite food for giraffes. Where will it grow? What colour will leaves be and why?</p>

<p>Over this half term, we will be learning about different 2D and 3D shapes. Can you find examples of these around your home and draw them into your homework book. Name and describe the shape.</p>  <p><u>Cereal Box</u> Cuboid - 6 faces, 8 vertices, 12 edges.</p>	<p>Can you write a diary entry as a cowboy. Imagine you are far from home transporting the cattle from the south to the north. Remember to include what you are doing and how you feel.</p> 	<p>Make something that a cowboy or a Native American would have used. That may be a prairie schooner, a wigwam - the choice is yours!! Be as creative as you like!</p> 



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
