School will be closed ALL children EXCEPT those who cannot stay at home safely and who:

Have an EHCP plan

Have an allocated social worker

Or have a parent who is defined as a key worker

The government's definition of a key worker includes those working in:

Health and Social Care e.g. NHS, social care and medical supplies etc

Education and Childcare e.g. nurseries, schools and social work

Key Public Services such as e.g. the justice system and religious staff

Local and National Government e.g. overseeing benefits etc.

Food and other necessary goods e.g. production, processing, distribution, sale and delivery

Public Safety and National Security e.g. police, armed forces, fire, prison and probation

Transport e.g. air, water, road and rail workers.

Utilities, Communication and Financial Services e.g. banking, oil, gas, electricity, water, IT, postal services and waste disposal.

EVERY CHILD WHO CAN BE SAFELY CARED FOR AT HOME SHOULD BE.

THIS IS AN OFFER TO PARENTS AND CARERS AND THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO SEND CHILDREN TO SCHOOL IF YOU DO NOT NEED OR WANT TO.
