




English challenge 3



Maths challenge I

Draw yourself a hopscotch like this below using chalk. When I was younger I used to try and find a good stone to make lines.

Throw a stone onto the hopscotch.

Jump one jump at a time to that number.

Can you jump on the number that is one more? Are you adding or taking away? If the number bigger or smaller than the number you started on?

Can you jump on the number that is one less?

Use stones and sticks to count that amount out.

I threw my stone on 7 above. I practised jumping to 7. Then I jumped one more and landed on the number 8. After I counted out 7 sticks. I got one more stick on now I have 8 sticks.

Encourage talking in full sentences.

I more than 7 is 8.
