It has been lovely, safely receiving all of the children back to school, after what seems a very long time away. The children have settled in to their new classes nicely and are learning the new rules to stay safe in the current climate. The week has been busy, with getting to know the new teaching staff, the class environment, and new friends. We have also reviewed each day and amended procedures to improve the smooth running of the day. Please see below for updates & reminders and many thanks for your co-operation.

Staggered Times

For families with more than 1 child—arrive at your first arrival slot and then doors will be open for the other children to go in to avoid waiting and playground congestion.

For families with only 1 child, do not arrive early, arrive at the allocated time.

Reminders/updates

- ◆ All children require a named water bottle to be brought daily
- ◆ Do not bring the fabric school bags
- ◆ Home lunches to be brought in disposal bags
- ◆ All children from year 1 upwards will have been issued their first reading book this week, these must be returned daily with the Home-School Links book. Nursery & Reception will be receiving their book soon.
- ◆ Previously, we delivered new class Information talks for parents, these will now be replaced with a presentation that will be uploaded to the website—we will inform you when these are available.
- ◆ As communication with the teacher on arrival and dismissal is now limited, if you require a conversation with the teacher please phone school and they will contact you at.
- ◆ Homework will be coming soon.

Nursery Funding Forms

All Nursery parents will need to come to the school office next week to sign their child's Parent Declaration for Early Education Funding forms.

All forms need signing no later than Friday 11th September for your child to complete their hours with us.

Office Procedures

If visiting the office can not be avoided then a face mask must be worn and only 1 person in at a time.

Medicines

If your child requires any medication in school time, this must be initially signed in by an adult at the school office.

Medicines from this point will then be taken to bubble bases and administered by the pupils' bubble staff. From this point on, medicines can be delivered and collected from the pupil's class entrance.

Lunchtime Supervisor Vacancy

We currently have a vacancy for a Lunchtime Supervisor.

The position is term time only from 12:00 - 1:00 each day with an hourly rate of £8.55.

Data Collection

Your child will come home on Monday with a pack including; a contact form, a medical form and a free school meals letter.

The contact and medical form need to be completed and returned back to school no later than Friday 18th September. This is to ensure all of your details that we have in school are correct and up to date.

If your child is already in receipt of free school meals, you don't need to complete and return this form. However if you think you are eligible, please return this with other completed documents.

Kool Kids

When dropping off/collecting from Kool Kids, please ring the bell and staff will bring the children out to you.
