Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you all enjoyed the Easter break, we have had a great first week back at school.

This week we have revisited our classroom rules and routines in line with our Covid risk assessment. Some of the restrictions are starting to lift in society but guidance for schools remains the same and so we are still learning, eating and playing in our class bubbles. We are following cleaning guidance in lessons and around school, as well as continuing to regularly wash our hands.

Please may we remind you that if your child shows symptoms please book a test, isolate and inform us immediately so that we can take advice and act accordingly.

To support us in keeping our school community safe please remember that only 1 adult per child for drop off and collection, avoid coming onto site early and crowding, keep to the one way system, use queue lines and keep a safe distance and a face covering must be worn unless exempt.

Your child will receive a school report in the week beginning 4th May 2021 to keep you updated on their attainment and progress. This will be sent home with your child.

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Bikes & Scooters

A number of children are arriving on bikes and scooters which is great to see, however please can they NOT be ridden on the playground to ensure the safety of everyone.

As part of our Covid risk assessment we have insisted that bikes and scooters are taken home to avoid any close contact when parking up. However I am happy to trial re-instating the leaving of bikes and scooters but in separate places to avoid children gathering from different bubbles. Nursery and Reception scooters are to left on the front yard as normal, Y1 and Y2 scooters to be left by the Nursery entrance and Y3 and Y4 by the railings at the side on the trim trail. These will not all be in the secured racks, so they will be left at your own risk.

If your are unsure where these areas are then please ask a member of staff.
