Next Steps:

- Appoint a clerical assistant at Knypersley to cover whilst Mr Howard is at Kingsfield.
- Review Leadership Structure at Knypersley First School
- Plan further shared training for parents.
- Gain agreement to begin consultation for Kingsfield First School to become a member of the Biddulph Partnership Trust.

- We have started to share a lot of resources and to do more joint planning:
- There is a governor visits policy
- Nursery staff have the opportunity to work together
- Staff from both schools attend the same training sessions
- Mr Finch (the caretaker) now works across both schools
- From April 2015 Mr Howard has become Bursar over both schools
- Parents have the opportunity to attend shared training sessions
- Kingsfield are now hiring the pool at Knypersley
- Literacy and Numeracy leaders are now working closely to moderate each other's work and to create a new curriculum with shared assessment systems. We are also working with James Bateman Junior High School on this.
- Maths leaders across both schools have written a new calculation policy.
