Set Menu: Timetables, spellings, daily reading, phonics practice

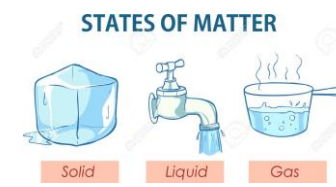
