How many ... do they think are there?

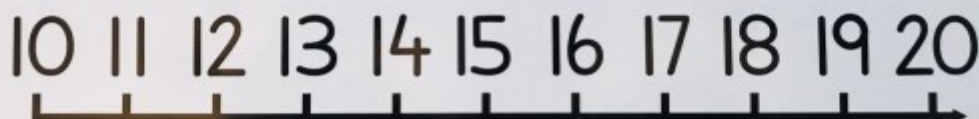


★ Have a count, who was closest? How far off were you?

Who lives down the lane.


























## Humpty Dumpty
