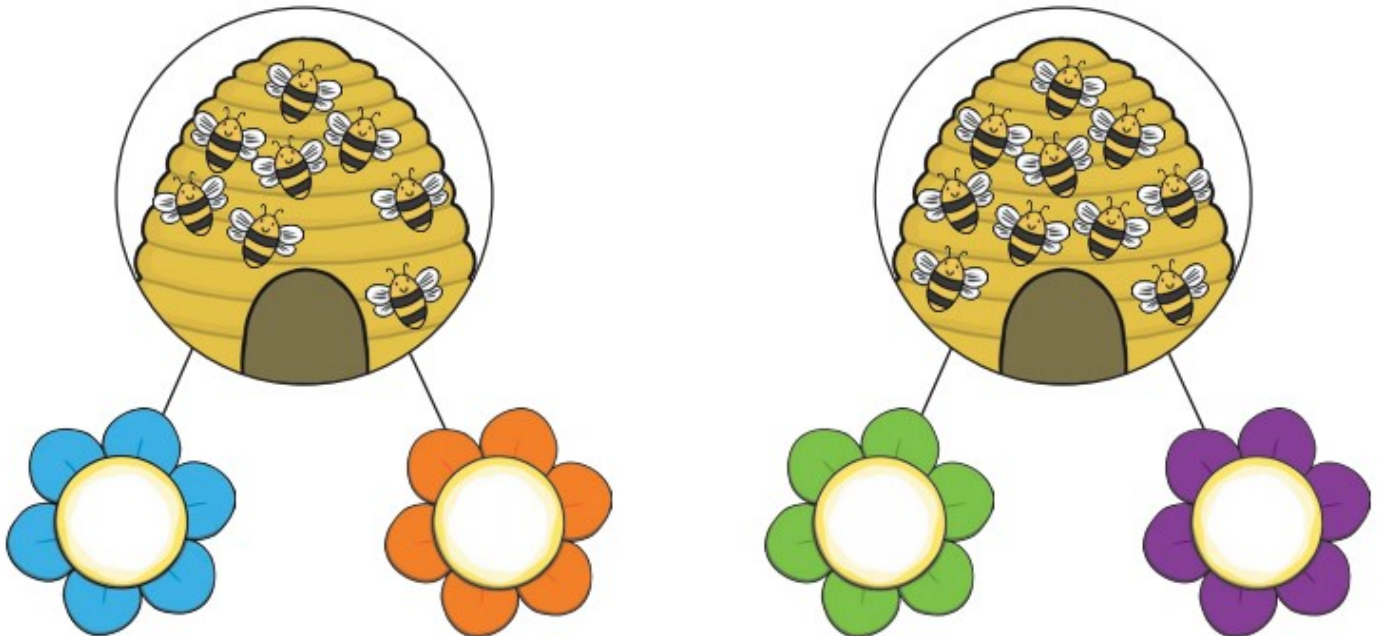
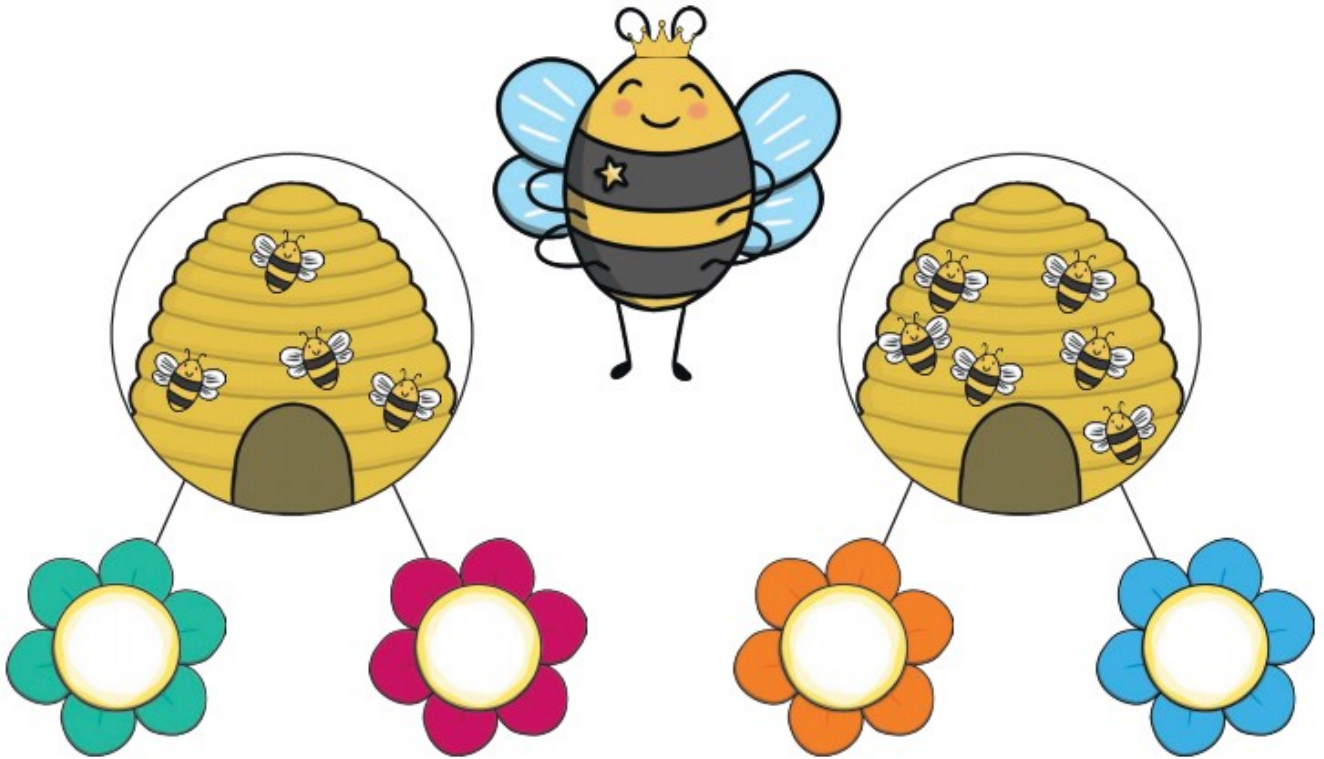
Can you count the total of eggs in the two Easter baskets. Remember to count each basket separately first and then count the total. Record your work if you want to either on the sheet or in your homework book!
