

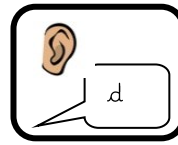

English	<p>Can you write some words to describe the fox and where he is. You may want to draw your own fox and label it.</p> <p>red fox run jump fast grass tree rock</p> <p>Extension Try putting some of the words together e.g. a red fox, run and jump</p>	<p>Can you write captions/sentences about the different parts of the Gruffalo's body.</p> <p>E.g He has terrible tusks / he has a green spot</p> <p>Make sure your caption/sentence makes sense!</p>	<p>Today you have a very tricky challenge. You are going to help Juila Donaldson to write a new character into the story. I have given you an idea that you can use below remembering to put in the repeating sentences. You may want to have the story to listen to from Monday to help you to remember. If you need to make it a little easier draw your new character and where they live and write a sentence or two about it.</p>	
Maths	<p>Can you draw around both of your hands as you will need these to measure with. You can decorate them if you like too. With your hands can you measure how long or how tall different objects are. You might want to find a way of recording. You could keep a board like the one below or write on post it notes/small bits of paper I have also attached a sheet with ideas of what you could measure.</p> <p>Once you have measured a few different objects try and compare them to find the longest or tallest object and the shortest and smallest object.</p> <p>If you record each object on a post it note or small bit of paper you may be able to order them. Explain how you know. Is the number bigger or smaller?</p> <p>For a challenge you might work out the difference. How many more is the longest compared to the shortest?</p>

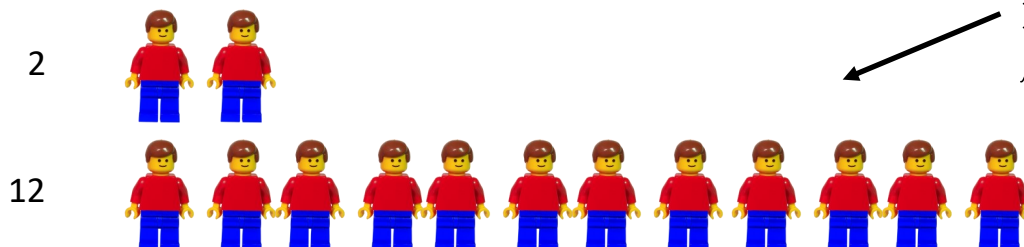
Maths Challenge

Draw around your hands and cut them out. Can you measure different objects and record how many hands long they are?



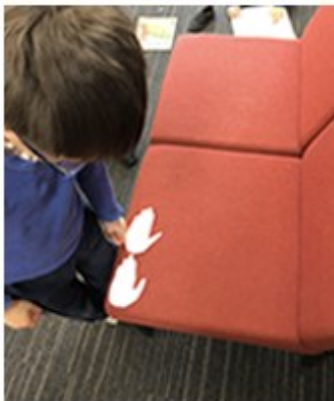
The boot has the shortest number of hands.

The scarf has the longest number of hands because the number is the biggest of them all.



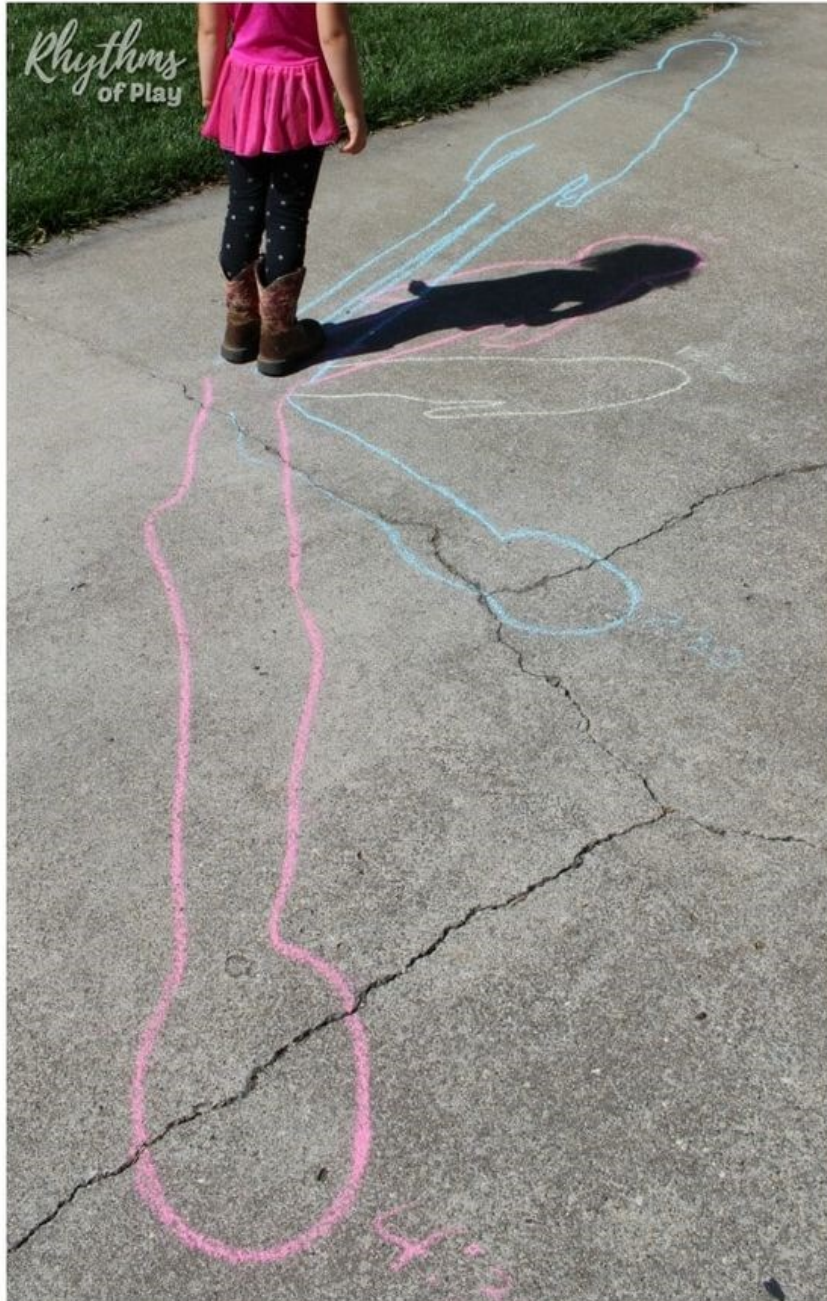
I can see that the scarf has 10 more hands than the boot.
