

wins or the board fills up.

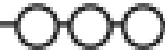
