









Her friends wanted to say goodbye.

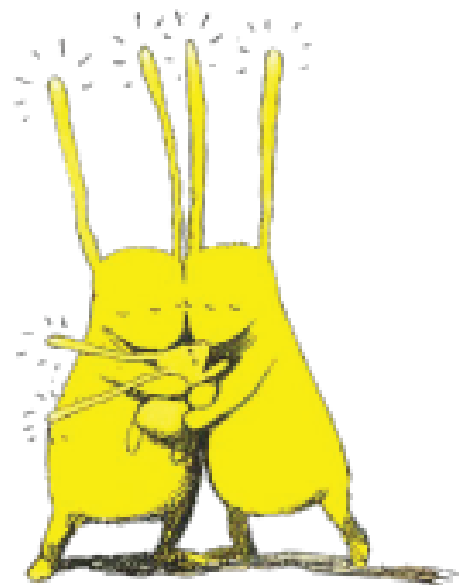
Goodbye!

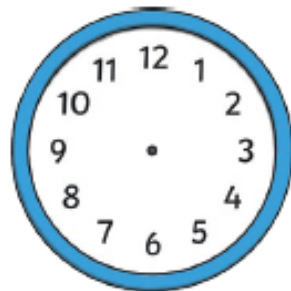
