Counting. -

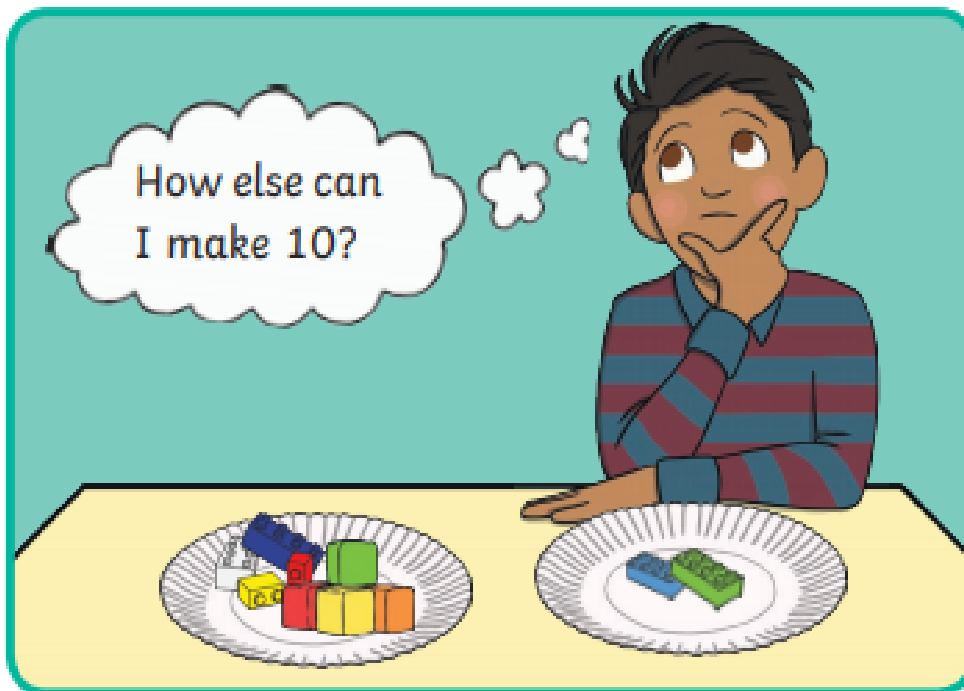
Make a Tower
