Keep reading anything you can. You can read books, magazines or even cereal packets.

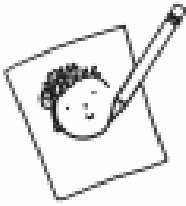
11 Make Up a Dance

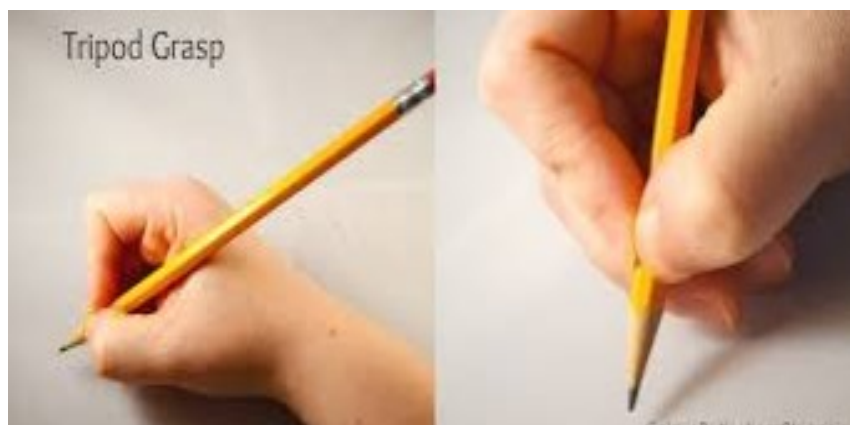


Tripod Grasp
