#### English - Challenge 2 & 3

#### Similes and Metaphors

Similes and metaphors are often confused. This work will help you to sort them out.

Simile - when something is 'like' or 'as' something.

E.g. The flower was sweet <u>like</u> honey. The flower was <u>as</u> sweet <u>as</u> honey.

Metaphor - when the object becomes what it is being compared to.

E.g. He was a roaring lion. (He wasn't like a roaring lion, or roaring as loud as a lion).




