## Ingredients:

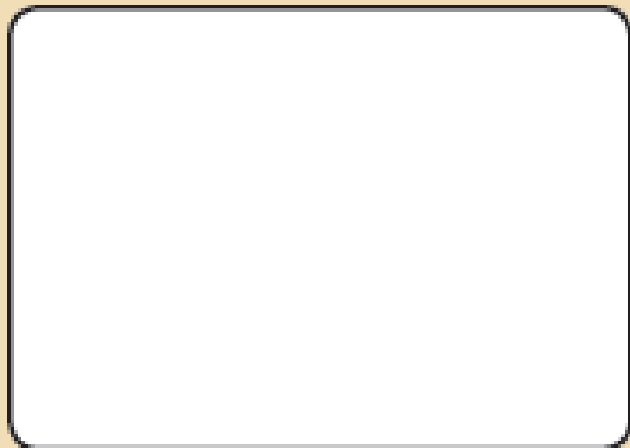
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Useful words: stir firstly add chop spiders eyeballs

0 legs

2 legs  
bird   
boy  girl

4 legs  
frog  cat   
dog 

6 legs  
ladybird   
fly  bee 

8 legs  
spider  


For example:

1 spider, 1 boy, 1 frog and 1 bee =  $8 + 2 + 4 + 6 = 20$
