Topic Task



Ingredients

- 6 rich tea or digestive biscuits
- 6 ice cream cones
- 100g milk chocolate
- Ready-to-roll green, orange and black icing
- Small amount of icing sugar and water for sticking

Equipment

- Scissors
- Microwaveable bowl
- Teaspoon
- Baking tray lined with greaseproof paper
- · Rolling pin
- Knife

Method

- Use the scissors to carefully cut the wide end off the ice cream cone. Make sure that it is flat.
- Break the chocolate into small pieces and place it in a microwaveable bowl.
- Melt the chocolate in the microwave on a low heat, stirring every 30 seconds or until it is melted.
- Dip the open end of each cone into the chocolate. This is so the cone sticks to the bisquit
- Place the cone in the centre of each biscuit and leave to set. Repeat with each one.
- Using a teaspoon, drizzle the chocolate over the ice cream cones and biscuits until they are completely covered.
- Place the biscuits on a greaseproof baking tray and put them in the fridge to set.
