

Bouncy and Stretchy Sounds

The single letter sounds make either a stretchy or a bouncy sound. It is important that you pronounce these sound 'pure'. The website has a video of how to say the sounds but a little trick...put the sound at the end of the word and listen to how it sounds (that will be the 'pure' way. E.g. 't' say 'cat' and you will hear it has no 'uh' on the end of it which is what we typically tend to do when saying single letter sounds!
