Dear Parents/Carers,

This week has brought it's challenges with a Y3/4 bubble having to isolate. Whilst we were doing our best to avoid this, we are chuffed to bits with how it has all gone.

I would like to thank all the parents for supporting the remote learning along with the staff who have worked really hard to, firstly make the remote lessons work and then ensured that learning continues and enjoyed. Parents have fully embraced this and whilst we do not want this to become the norm, we hope that it has been manageable.

Some points to perhaps to take forward are that we ask children and parents to be mindful that there is only one teacher communicating to a full class along with their parents, so please be patient when awaiting a response and be considerate when and how often you are sending messages. It is also worth adding that if you have not already set up your child's email/Teams I really urge you to do so, as in the event of a bubble needing to move to remote lessons, it is one less thing to sort out.

We are taking all precautions to keep your children safe and well at school, but if your child is ill, it is absolutely imperative that you phone and tell us why, then their symptoms can be discussed and we can advise.
