This week our Health & Safety governor completed a premises walk to check that our systems are safe and effective and the feedback from this was very positive. Thank you in your support in keeping us safe especially by wearing face masks, keeping to the staggered start and pick up times and maintaining social distancing on the play ground.

Next week we enter the festive month of December and we have lots of Covid safe Christmas surprises planned for both the children and parents! With the increase in the COVID 19 cases in the local area, we are asking for your support to discourage the use of children's own hand sanitiser.
