Our whole school target is 97.5%

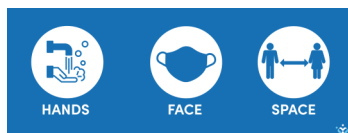
Covid Reminders

The main Covid-19 symptoms to be aware of are:-

- A new continuous cough
- Fever or high temperature
- A loss of or change in the sense of smell or taste

If a child develops any of these symptoms it is vital that they should isolate and book a test.

Whilst waiting for test results all members of the household should isolate.



School Covid Procedures

- Only 1 adult per child for drop off and collection.
- Avoid coming onto site early and crowding.
- Keep to the one way system.
- Use queue lines and keep a safe distance.
- Face covering must be worn unless exempt.

No toys to be brought into school

No book bags

PE kits worn on PE days

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain at home for at **least 10 days** from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119.

All other household members who remain well must stay at home and not leave the house for 10 days.

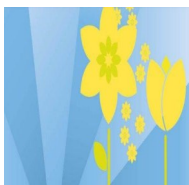
The 10-day period starts from the day after the first person in the house became ill.

Household members should not go to work, school or public areas and exercise should be taken within the home.

Household members staying at home for 10 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community.
