Current eligibility criteria are if you are in receipt of:	
-Income Support	
I -Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance	
-Income-related Employment and Support Allowance	
-Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999	
The guaranteed element of Pension Credit -Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross	
income of no more than £16,190)	
-Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit	
l -Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) .

Staffordshire County Council are offering families who claim free school meals the chance to get free first-time central heating installed in their homes.
