RED WORDS - Tricky Word Games

'you can't fred red' — you can't sound out these words you just need to learn them by sight.

Below are a few different activities you can do to help your child to retain and remember their tricky red words!

Make yourself some stepping stones using the tricky words. An adult says a word and the child has to jump on, or place a toy on the word and read what it says.



Puzzy tricky words – write the words on the back of puzzle pieces and say the word as you pick up the piece. You may just have 5 words but repeated.



TIPS

- Focus on 5 or 6 at a time
- Little and often
- One they know some of them you could just narrow it down to 2 but have 3 or 4 lots of those 2 words
- Once they know some always review them at least once or twice a week or they may forget them!

Tricky word car park – tell your child where to park the car – want to make this girly? A field with stables – put the horse in the stable. Or the

princess to castle



Place a word on each stair and practise reading them as you go up and down the stairs. Please

be careful though!



Roll and read or bingo!



Other ideas:

- Treasure hunt
- Spot all the 'to' tricky words in your library book
- Skittles with words on knock over say the words that got knocked down
