Length and Height

- We will learn to compare lengths and heights and begin to measure.

Weight and Volume

- We will learn to measure and compare mass.
- We will learn to measure and compare capacity.

English

- We will write fact files.
- We will know features of non fiction texts.
- We will read stories about castles.
- We will write descriptions of settings.
- We will act out different roles.
- We will listen to and write poetry.
- We will use our phonic knowledge to blend unfamiliar words.
- We will learn high frequency words.

History/Geography

- We will learn 'old', 'new' and 'a long time ago'.
- We will learn that some famous people have helped our lives to be better today.
- We will learn that we have a queen who rules us.
- We will learn to celebrate certain events because of what happened long ago.
- We will recognise similarities and differences in my immediate environment.
- We will identify and record daily weather patterns and discuss any changes.
- We will learn about seasons and relate the changes in weather to changes in clothing and activities.

PSHRE/ RE

- We will learn to about families and the Church as God's family.
- We will learn that people are paid money for the job they do
- We will learn how to recognise the difference between needs and wants.
- We will learn how people make choices about spending money.

Art/Design

- We will create art in the style Paul Klee.
- We will learn to share ideas about what art is and where it can be found.
- We will learn to cut ingredients safely and hygienically.

Computing

- We will learn devices have to be given instructions.
- We will learn that when you give a device a command it runs some code to know what to do.
- We will learn instructions need to be broken down in to small pieces.
- We will learn how to make a BeeBot move.
- We will learn S stands for safe, M stands for meet, A stands for accept, R stands for Reliable and T stands for tell.

Music

- We will use our voices.
- We will follow instructions.
- We will listen to and talk about music.
- We will think about pulse, rhythm and pitch.
- We will begin to improvise and compose.

PE

- We will learn to copy and explore different movements and basic body patterns.
- We will learn to link movements to sound and music.
- We will learn how to suggest improvements to performances.

Science

- We will learn that there are four season.
- We will learn how the seasons change during the year.
- We will learn that there are different weather types and will be able to name these (such as rain, sun, wind, fog)
- We will learn how the day changes in length throughout the year(longer in Summer and shorter in Winter)
