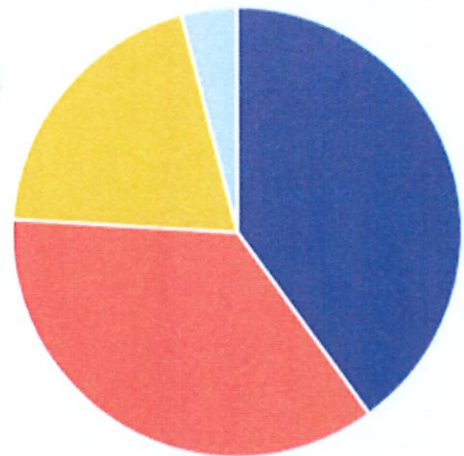
How it works...

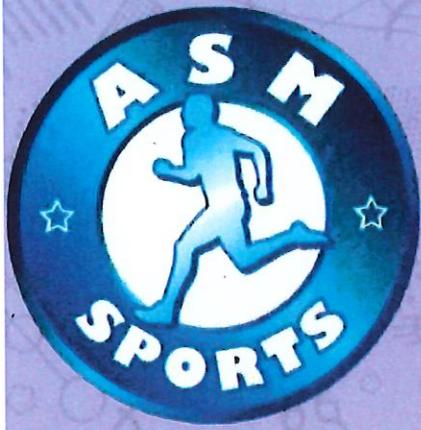
