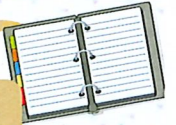

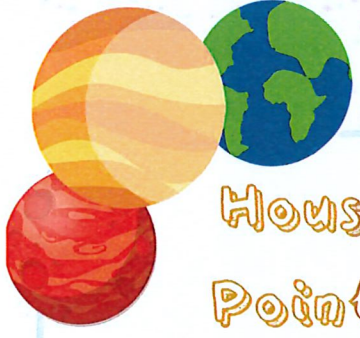
*Well done to Jesse who has passed his stage 5 in swimming*

# This week our spotlight is on our PE curriculum...



## OUR PE CURRICULUM

Our PE curriculum is based on a range of skills covering: Dance, Gymnastics, Games, Athletics, Forest School and Swimming. We teach the children key skills which they then develop through games, sequences and competitions.

## PE IN KEY STAGE 1 AND 2

We have completed some fantastic Dance sequences in Key Stage 1 and 2 and even used some of it in our amazing Nativities. We have listened to music and created movements to an idea or story to a set count of 8. We have worked hard to copy and repeat dance movements shown and have loved moving our bodies to the beat. Key Stage 2 have focused on canon and unison, using our levels and different speeds to convey different ideas.

We are excited for our play ground leaders to have an afternoon refresher and look forward to our health and well being day and 2025 Health and sports week, including Sports Day!



## PE IN EYES

We use and develop our PE skills on a daily basis in EYFS and we love to explore many different areas of PE including Games, Dance and Gymnastics. We also love to explore our gross and fine motor skills in our provision and in the outdoor area.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY
