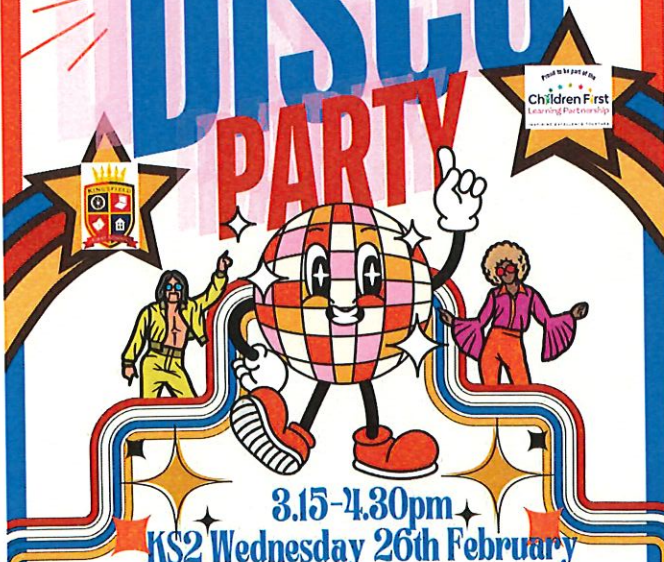

Reception—Jack & The Beanstalk

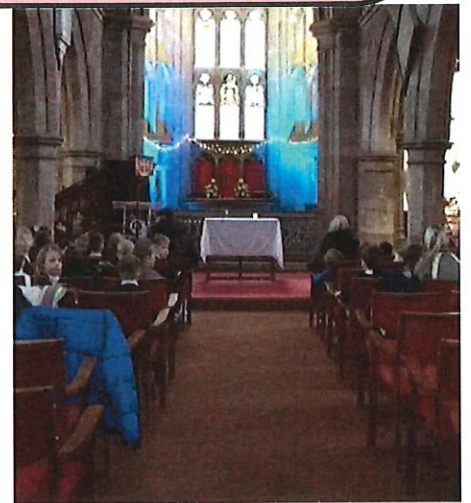
