

This week our spooling is on the upcoming changes to waste management...





Until recently, the law did not require a business to recycle; it was a choice. But now the law is changing. From **31st March 2025**, all business premises **must** arrange to have all:

- dry recyclable waste (glass, cans, plastic, paper and card) collected for recycling;
-) food waste separately collected for recycling.

Colour Coded Bin Lids

- General Waste
- Plastics & Metals
- Food Waste
- Cardboard & Paper
- Glass

Our Eco Warriors will be overseeing the changes in our school and will be supporting our school community with ensuring the correct items go in the correctly coloured bins. This will help in our quest to achieve our green flag award too!

Children that have packed lunches will now be bringing the items from their lunch boxes back home with them -this will not only help with the management of recycling within school, but will also allow you to see what your child has/ has not eaten that day.
